

The Saffron Walden Heritage Development Group, in partnership with Saffron Walden Museum, St. Mary's Church, Saffron Walden Business Improvement District and Colonel John Pickering's Regiment of the Sealed Knot Society, are hosting a costumed interpretative drama in the Parish Church of St. Mary's, Saffron Walden.

Colonel Pickering's Regiment will then perform 'Living History' and present a display of 17th. century arms at Saffron Walden Museum and on nearby Castle Green.

Saffron Walden Heritage Development Group is engaged in the commissioning of a sculpture celebrating Saffron Walden's unique role in the development of elected representative democracy.

For in Saffron Walden during the Spring of 1647 elected 'Agitators' were raised from the ranks of the Parliamentary Army which had defeated the King during the English Civil War. These individuals became politically active and went on to influence major decisions.
